






How old are you?


Here is a something called a color palette.

Decorating Tools



For drawing, you will need a drawing pencil and a black pen. I use a pure liquid ink pen for my outlines. When you are colouring you can use either watercolors or color pencils or watercolor pencils. I use Staedtler and Faber-Castell. Both are based in Germany. When painting, slip a thick card-paper/ thinner cardboard between the pages so that the other page does not absorb the water/

Tip: Color in a light background for better results.

Let's start—by doing a colouring page! This one is a bowl of sweets.

Cut up yarn pieces and glue them here.

Glue pressed flowers/leaves on this page

Cut out small pieces of colored paper and glue them together, to make a mosaic.

Here we are going to do a project. Remember on page 21 you made a mosaic? Well, we're going to do that now, but we are going to MAKE the paper from scratch. First grab a paper, and using watercolor paints and a brush, paint the whole paper with all the colors you like. If you want bright colors try something like:


Blush, jadeite, canary yellow, jungle green, vermillion, starfish orange and sherbet orange.

You might not have these specific shades, but I'm quite sure you can pick them up from your local craft store. After painting, cut vertical strips of paper, then horizontal.

Gradient this page, then add in an element that matches your theme.








Color this page black.




